Responsibilities and Tasks

- Clean and maintain stables/kennels on a daily basis
- Clean and maintain stables/kennel equipment
- Provide each animal with food and water following approved feeding protocols.
- Wash/sanitize food and water bowls, feed tubs and outside horse waterers.
- Observe animals for any health issues and report to the Stables Manager.
- Spend time with dogs, providing "hands on" enrichment and socialization.
- Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualification Requirements

This position requires a high school diploma and a love of working with animals; some experience preferred. Valid Driver's license required.

Special Working Conditions

Working conditions include hot and cold temperatures, intense noise, and lifting or carrying heavy objects. Must be able to bend and squat regularly and stand for long periods of time.
